 - Viable *Oncorhynchus mykiss* population (Steelhead/Rainbow Trout)
 - Science and community-based watershed protection and restoration program
- **Components**
 - Fish population monitoring
 - Fish habitat monitoring
 - Water quality monitoring
 - Education and outreach
 - Working with residents to create fish-friendly backyards
 - Design and implementation of priority restoration project

 - Install step-pools
 - Establish native plant community
