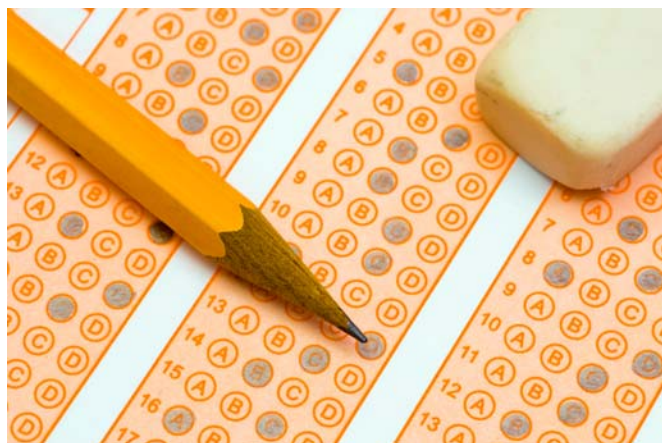

Seventh graders, are you thinking ahead to high school?

If so, Saint Mary's would like to offer you a day of support.

The high school application process requires you to take a standardized test. For the East Bay Catholic schools, this test is the HSPT (High School Placement Test). On **Saturday, May 8, 2010 from 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.**, Saint Mary's will be hosting an opportunity for 100 seventh graders to participate in a **Seventh Grade Workshop and Practice Test**. This practice test is intended to help students become more familiar with the different sections of the HSPT, especially under timed conditions.

You must register in advance. RESERVATIONS ARE TAKEN ON A FIRST COME, FIRST SERVE BASIS. Results of the exam will be mailed home to families in May as a tool for them to assess their child's personal strengths and areas for growth. The results will include academic suggestions from Saint Mary's for improvement in reading, writing, and mathematics, if needed. Test results are strictly confidential and are not sent to the student's school or kept at Saint Mary's College High School.

Many past participants of this workshop have told us that this experience made their high school testing experience easier and less stressful. We hope that you take advantage of this opportunity.

### FAQs and 2010 Registration Form

**1. What time does the Seventh Grade Workshop begin?**

*The 7th Grade Workshop program will take place on Saturday morning, May 8, 2010 at Saint Mary's campus and begins promptly at 8:30 a.m. in the auditorium. Check-in begins at 8:00 a.m.*

**2. Is it necessary for the parent(s) to attend?**

Parents are invited to attend the morning welcome and overview in the auditorium. Once students have been directed to classrooms, members of the Saint Mary's administration and staff will be available from 8:30 a.m. to 9:00 a.m. to meet and greet parents and answer any questions about Saint Mary's and its program.

**3. What will the seventh grade students need to bring on that day?**

Students will need to bring two #2 pencils and something to read while they are waiting.

**5. Does my child need to bring a lunch?**

Saint Mary's will provide refreshments and a lunch for participating students during the day. If your child is on a special diet, please send an appropriate lunch with them on this day.

**6. When will families get the results of the standardized exam?**

Narrative exam results will be mailed home in mid-May along with general academic suggestions sponsored by the Curriculum Committee at Saint Mary's. Exam results will not be mailed to the student's current school.
